Dance Styles

Pre Junior Fairy dancing

The Fairy Dancing[™] Program is unique, as it provides opportunities for children to immerse themselves in The Fairies[™] experience, and to participate in a learning environment which uses music, movement, and dance to develop children's cognitive, emotional and social needs.

By associating fairies with dancing, the art of dance is transformed into a magical experience that children will cherish.

Jazz

These exciting classes focus on fun style and energising technique. We include a warm up, stretching and corner work in each class.

By attending this class students gain a skill base of co-ordination, balance, rhythm, musicality and posture.

Тар

This is a style of dance that allows your feet to be the accompaniment. Tap offers a high-energy style of dance that combines rhythm with technique.

BAL Ballet

Ballet is the basic structure for all forms of dance.

Our ballet classes are carefully designed to develop the essentials for good dance technique. This means that posture, movement quality, balance and co-ordination are carefully monitored.

Hip Hop

Hip Hop is now an accepted, distinct style of dance which is rapidly increasing in popularity.

CSDS classes offer a fast paced enjoyable class with moves that will not only challenge the mind and body but showcase all aspects of the hip hop style.

Lyrical

Lyrical or Modern Expressive is a style that incorporates slow and expressive dance movements. CSDS classes allow students to use their ballet technique more openly while being encouraged to add feeling to their dance style.



Dance Styles

Contemporary

Contemporary or modern dance is a style that takes free natural movements but incorporates them into the technique and structure of ballet or jazz.

In our classes we aim to overlay the discipline of more traditional styles of dance with open interpretations.

Gymnastics

Gymnastics is one of the most exciting forms of physical exercise. Great for the youngsters, it strengthens muscles, improves co-ordination and builds self confidence.

Concerts

Every student has the opportunity to perform in our Mid Year and End of year concerts. Concerts give our families the opportunity to watch our students showcase what they have been working on in classes and provides a sense of pride and achievement while in a encouraging environment.

Costumes

Over the years we have built up a huge range of costumes to hire. Rather than buying costumes to only be worn once we make it super carefree for our families. Hire fees will be added to your child's class fees during terms 2 and 4.

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Attendance

We believe class attendance is super important. By committing to your weekly classes helps teachers with concert routines and your dancer's sense of commitment and purpose each and every week.

At CSDS we understand your dancer may be sick or injured. If possible we encourage our students to sit in and observe their classes.

Please let our admin staff know if you know ahead of time for trips planned or school events.

Sick or hurt

If your dancer is going to be away due to sickness please call our admin staff. Unfortunately we don't offer makeup classes or refunds for missed classes.

If your dancer is injured during class please remind them to let their teacher know immediately and take advice on what to do or not do.

Ambulance policy

If an ambulance is needed all associated costs will be parent's responsibility. If it is not urgent parents will be informed first.

Insurance (students are not cover for personal injury/ambulance if you want this cover information can be provided)



Studio Policies

To ensure the safe smooth running of CSDS and an enjoyable experience for all, we ask you read the policies bellow.

If you choose to be a Centre Stage Dance Studio student, we do not allow our students to take any classes at other dance studios or clubs, unless it is in a style that we do not teach (such as Irish or Cheerleading). CSDS students must only be taught by current CSDS staff only. Elite students may be asked by Miss April to enter Dancer of the year at Hollywood Bound. With Approval by Miss April an elite choreographer that is not affiliated with another studio or club may be invited to choreograph.

We expect all dancers to be fully prepared before class. Help students prepare their dance bag and supplies the day before. Make sure they are dressed out in uniform, with hair pulled up in an acceptable form Arrive 10 minutes early to give dancer time to warm up

Any questions or feedback must go directly through our admin term or Miss April we ask parents and students do not contact CSDS teachers via phone, email or social media. We ask that you respect our teachers privacy and work hours by not contacting them personally.

We want the best learning experience for your dancer. We place dancers in the level we believe they will learn the most. If a dancer feels that they are not getting the most out of their experience, we will work with them on ways to increase their learning within that same class.

Your dancer will follow your example; if you trust the dance instructors judgement and show them respect, your dancer will do the same. This creates the best and most positive learning environment for everyone.
