

Registration

Dance Styles

Lil Groovers Hip Hop

In this pre and early school program, your child's own individuality will shine through as they learn how to groove in rhythm and express themselves through movement. Through our structured, weekly Lil Groovers program, they'll have the opportunity to learn, dance, laugh and have fun as they progress naturally through the use of props, Cyphers, freestyling, and fundamentals.

Jazz

These exciting classes focus on fun style and energizing technique. We include a warm up, stretching and corner work in each class.

By attending this class students gain a skill base of co-ordination, balance, rhythm, musicality and posture.

Tap

This is a style of dance that allows your feet to be the accompaniment. Tap offers a high-energy style of dance that combines rhythm with technique.

BAL Ballet

Ballet is the basic structure for all forms of dance.

Our ballet classes are carefully designed to develop the essentials for good dance technique. This means that posture, movement quality, balance and co-ordination are carefully monitored.

Hip Hop

Hip Hop is now an accepted, distinct style of dance which is rapidly increasing in popularity.

CSDS classes offer a fast paced enjoyable class with moves that will not only challenge the mind and body but showcase all aspects of the hip hop style.

Lvrical

Lyrical or Modern Expressive is a style that incorporates slow and expressive dance movements. CSDS classes allow students to use their ballet technique more openly while being encouraged to add feeling to their dance style.



Dance Styles

Contemporary

Contemporary or modern dance is a style that takes free natural movements but incorporates them into the technique and structure of ballet or jazz.

In our classes we aim to overlay the discipline of more traditional styles of dance with open interpretations.

Gymnastics

Gymnastics is one of the most exciting forms of physical exercise. Great for the youngsters, it strengthens muscles, improves co-ordination and builds self confidence.

Students will be assessed prior to being assigned to a class

- Tiny Gymnastics 2-5 years
- Beginners 6yrs and older Students at a beginner level
- Intermediate must be able to cartwheel
- Advance must be able do forward/back walk over

Singing

Learn how to hold a tune while having fun at the same time. CSDS offers classes for beginners right through to advanced singing levels.

From traditional songs to the latest pop and RnB songs, our advanced students compete in various competitions and concerts.

Musical Theatre

To bring out the actor within, build self-confidence or just to feel at home in front of an audience.

Whatever the reason, Musical Theatre is a great way to tap into your creative side. Learn how to project your voice, to breathe correctly and to relax as you speak.

Class Fees

Fees are charged in order to maintain placing in classes. This fee is compulsory if the student misses their class. Fees can be paid to our friendly receptionist and is recorded in your file for you to see n the parent portal.

Refunds will not be offered for missed classes and makeup classes are not available.

Direct Debit

This is our preferred and most simple payment method where you can choose to pay weekly through our Dance Studio Pro parent portal.

Fees paid online incur transactional admin fees on top of class fees.

Upfront Payment

If you prefer to pay upfront for the term it can be done either online or in person at the studio. This option allows you to pay fees by the Term within the first 3 weeks. You will be sent an invoice for the full term at the start of each term.

If payments are late there will be late fees added in your parent portal.

Attendance

We believe class attendance is super important. By committing to your weekly classes helps teachers with concert routines and your dancer's sense of commitment and purpose each and every week.

At CSDS we understand your dancer may be sick or injured. If possible we encourage our students to sit in and observe their classes.

Please let our admin staff know if you know ahead of time for trips planned or school events.

Sick or hurt

If your dancer is going to be away due to sickness please call our admin staff. Unfortunately we don't offer makeup classes or refunds for missed classes.

If your dancer is injured during class please remind them to let their teacher know immediately and take advice on what to do or not do.

Ambulance policy

If an ambulance is needed all associated costs will be parent's responsibility. If it is not urgent parents will be informed first.

Studio Policies

To ensure the safe and smooth operation of CSDS and to provide an enjoyable experience for all, please familiarize yourself with the following policies:

1. Exclusive Enrollment at Centre Stage Dance Studio:

 As a Centre Stage Dance Studio student, we prohibit attending classes at other dance studios or clubs unless it involves a dance style not taught at our studio (e.g., Irish or Cheerleading).

2. Preparation and Punctuality:

- Dancers are expected to be fully prepared for class, including having their dance bag and supplies ready the day before.
- Ensure dancers are dressed in uniform, with hair appropriately styled.
- Arrive 10 minutes early to allow time for warm-up.

3. Communication Protocol:

Any questions or feedback should be directed to our admin team or Miss April.
 We kindly request that parents and students refrain from contacting CSDS teachers via phone, email, or social media to respect their privacy and work hours.

4. Payment Options:

• Payment can be made through weekly Auto-Pay or as an upfront payment within the first 3 weeks of the term. Failure to pay may result in late fees, and parents are responsible for any dishonor fees.

5. Optimizing Learning Experience:

- We aim to provide the best learning experience for your dancer by placing them in the level we believe will maximize their learning.
- If a dancer feels they are not fully benefiting from their experience, we are open to working with them to enhance their learning within the same class.

6. Promoting a Positive Environment:

Your dancer will follow your example; therefore, trust in the dance instructors'
judgment and show them respect. This fosters a positive learning environment
for everyone involved.
